Chairman Broadhead called the meeting to order at 7:00 pm and led the attendees in the Pledge of Allegiance.

Administrative Business

Motion: To approve the minutes of January 16, 2014 as amended. Motion by Chairman Broadhead, second by Carla Penfield. All in favor, motion carried with Vice-Chair Chivers abstaining.

Old/New Business

Chairman Broadhead reminded the members of the Budget Committee that the purpose for the meeting was to vote on amendments made at the February 1st Town Budget Deliberative Session to two warrant articles.

With regard to Article 2, an amendment to the total operating budget amount (excluding special warrant articles and other appropriations voted separately), increasing the original amount of \$2,377,975 to \$2,427,975, was proposed and approved by the voters. The new amount includes \$50,000 for the possible closure of the old incinerator site.

Motion: To approve Article 2 as amended. Motion by Judith Szot, second by Selectman Robie. All in favor, motion carried.

With regard to Article 18, an amendment to the total operating expenses for the Smyth Public Library, decreasing the original amount of \$133,880 to \$132,680, was proposed and approved by the voters. The new amount is the result of a \$1,200 decrease in projected health insurance costs.

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Motion: To approve Article 18 as amended. Motion by Allyn Chivers, second by Judith Szot. All in favor, motion carried.

Adjourn

Motion: To adjourn. Motion by Christine Watson, second by Allyn Chivers. All in favor, motion carried.
