

### **Recyclables**

**Mix paper** – 18 bales = 23,474 lbs. or 11.743 tons.

**Cardboard** – 9 bales = 9,888 lbs. or 4.94 tons.

**Tin Cans** – 5 bales = 4468 lbs. or 2.23 tons.

**#1 -#7 plastics** – 5 bales = 4415 lbs. or 2.20 tons.

**Aluminum cans** – 2 bales = 1426 lbs. = .71 tons

**#2 natural plastic** – 1 bale = 710 lbs. or .36 tons.

There were 40 bales created for the month of February 2012 which weighed 44,381 lbs. or 22.19 tons. There was also one glass haul which weighed 22,720 lbs. or 11.36 tons and one electronics container hauled which weighed 6,240 lbs. or 3.11 tons. This gives a grand total of 73,320 lbs. or 36.66 tons of material recycled for the month.

On 2/21 the paper/cardboard container was marketed with 20.56 tons of mix paper and 6.50 tons of cardboard. This generated approx. **\$1,300** in revenue.
