Work Summary:


There were 2 plowable storms and 4 sand/salt runs

Moore Park

The park is coming to life again, with the mild winter giving the people opportunities to show up before Winter became Spring and activities started up. The Easter Egg Hunt went off April 1st, as scheduled, two weeks early this year. A great success, as usual, thanks to the efforts of Linda McCabe and the other dedicated volunteers. I've got lots of pictures and memories. There is a Field Day scheduled for next Saturday, April 14th, rain or shine. Many different town groups are helping out. Help from the public welcomed and has been solicited. The Moore School softball season has started with a full schedule. CYAA will, again this year, not be using the facilities at Moore Park on a regular basis. The Road Agent will be giving the basketball court its annual professional sweeping and doing road maintenance. The bathrooms are up and running. Minor repairs and maintenance are scheduled and the playing fields are being reviewed for possible turf improvements. Equipment repair in the playground is scheduled and in-process.

Skateboard Park

The additional equipment installed in the park last year has been repaired and is now fully functional and is being used on a daily basis. We're still considering the possibility of getting some surplus structures from another town.

Summer Recreation & Ski Program

The ski programs, one for the younger kids in Manchester and the Pats Peak program for the older kids, are wrapped up and, by all accounts, went smoothly and were enjoyed by all. CYAA did a super job of managing the program and the final cost to the town was minimal. The excess of the appropriation is scheduled to be reallocated to other line items in the budget. A review of the funding mechanism for the program is in-process. No specific town summer recreation programs are scheduled, but we'll be working with the CYAA and other groups, entities and organizations to provide support to their programs.
