

The Candia Recycling Center (CRC) land-filled **77.05** tons of Municipal Solid Waste (MSW) during July of 2012, the CRC land-filled **69.49** tons of MSW during July of 2011, in July of 2010 the CRC land-filled **55.09** tons of MSW and in July of 2009 the CRC land-filled **64.06** tons of MSW.

The CRC disposed of **43.43** tons of C&D debris during July of 2012, the CRC disposed of **60.36** tons of C&D debris during July of 2011, the CRC disposed of **48.42** tons of C&D debris during July of 2010 and the CRC disposed of **49.62** tons of C&D debris during July of 2009.

The total amount of waste processed by the CRC during July 2012 was **120.48** tons, the total amount of waste processed by the CRC during July of 2011 was **133.55** tons, the total amount of waste processed by the CRC during July of 2010 was **103.51** tons and the total amount of waste processed by the CRC during July of 2009 was **113.68** tons.

17.29 tons of recyclables plus **10.52** tons of glass and the **3.11** tons of electronics gives a grand total of **30.92** tons recycled during July of 2012.
