January 2014

The Candia Recycling Center land-filled **54.88** tons of Municipal Solid Waste (MSW) during January 2014. The Candia Recycling Center land-filled **68.79** tons of MSW during January 2013. The Candia Recycling center land-filled **67.78** tons of MSW during January 2012. The CRC had land-filled **52.84** tons of MSW during January of 2011. The CRC had land-filled **60.52** tons of MSW during January 2010 and the CRC land-filled **52.67** tons of MSW during January 2009.

The Candia Recycling Center disposed of **26.56** tons of C&D debris during January of 2014. The CRC disposed of **20.89** tons of C&D debris in January of 2013. The CRC land-filled **26.76** tons of C&D debris during January 2012: the CRC land-filled **16.53** tons of C&D debris in January of 2011, the CRC land-filled **19.30** tons of debris in January 2010, the CRC land-filled **24.74** tons of C&D debris in January 2009.

The CRC processed **81.44** tons of waste during January 2014. The CRC processed **89.68** tons of waste during January 2013. The CRC processed **94.54** tons of waste during January 2012: the CRC processed **69.37** tons of waste in January 2011, the CRC processed **79.82** tons of waste in January 2010, the CRC processed **77.41** tons of waste in January 2009.

Recyclables

Mix paper – 17 bales = 22446 lbs. = 11.22 tons

Cardboard – 6 bales 7090 lbs. = 3.55 tons

#1 -#7 plastics –5 bales = 4421 lbs. =2.21 tons

#2 natural plastic – 1 bale = 710 lbs. = .36tons

Aluminum cans – 2 bales = 584 lbs. = .29 tons

There were **35** bales created which weighed **38,894** lbs. or **19.45** tons during January 2014.

There was one glass haul which weighed **20,900** lbs. or **10.45** tons. There was one electronics container swap which weighed **6200** lbs. or **3.10** tons. The total amount of recycled material for the month of January 2014 was **65,994** lbs. or **32.99** tons.

We received a **\$1711.80** check in January for a load of mixed paper and cardboard in December, because it wasn't received by 12/31 it is revenue towards 2014.

On 1/14 – we sent out 16 tons of mix paper and 5.78 tons of cardboard which generated **\$1573** in revenue.

On 1/31 we sent out 23,720 lbs. of scrap metal which generated **\$2194** in revenue.

Total revenue received in January 2014 was **\$5478**.

February 2014

MSW

During February 2014 the Candia Recycling center land-filled **47.75** tons of Municipal Solid Waste (MSW). The Candia Recycling Center land-filled **46.47** tons of MSW during February 2013. The Candia recycling Center land-filled **41.42** tons of MSW during February 2012. The Candia Recycling Center land-filled **45.74** tons of MSW during February 2011 and the Candia Recycling Center land-filled **35.99** tons of MSW during February 2010. The Candia Recycling Center land-filled **41.30** tons of MSW during February 2009.

During February 2014 the Candia Recycling Center disposed of **16.63** tons of C&D debris. The Candia Recycling Center disposed of **16.60** tons of C&D debris during February 2013. The Candia recycling Center disposed of **30.50** tons of C&D debris during February 2012. The Candia Recycling Center disposed of **25.61** tons of C&D debris during February 2011 and the Candia recycling Center disposed of 13.89 tons of C&D debris during February 2010. The Candia Recycling Center disposed of **24.74** tons of C&D debris during February 2009.

The total amount of waste processed for February 2014 was **64.38** tons. The total amount of waste processed for the month of February 2013 was **63.07** tons. The total amount of waste processed for the month of February 2012 was **71.92** tons. The total amount of waste processed in February 2011 was **71.35** tons. The total amount of waste processed during February 2010 was **49.88** tons and the total amount of waste processed during February 2009 was **66.04** tons.

Recyclables

The baler was down for all of February. We sent out two loose loads of Mix paper and two loads of cardboard.

Mix paper – 2 loose hauls @ \$225 per haul = \$450 in haul fees
9.09 tons @ \$20 per ton = \$181.80

Cardboard – 2 loose hauls @ \$225 per haul = \$450 in haul fees
4.60 tons @ \$95 per ton = \$437.

The four loose loads sent out cost \$900, and generated \$618.80.

March 2014

MSW

The Candia Recycling Center land-filled **49.05** tons of Municipal Solid Waste (MSW) during March 2014. The Candia Recycling Center had land-filled **56.03** tons of MSW during March 2013. The Candia recycling Center had land-filled **57.37** tons of MSW during March 2012. The Candia Recycling Center land-filled **56.48** tons of MSW during March 2011 and the Candia Recycling Center land-filled **52.40** tons of MSW during March 2010. The Candia Recycling Center land-filled **51.21** tons of MSW during March 2009.

The Candia Recycling Center disposed of **18.35** tons of C&D debris during March 2014. The Candia Recycling Center disposed of **27.79** tons of C&D debris during March 2013. The Candia recycling Center disposed of **36.95** tons of C&D debris during March 2012. The Candia Recycling Center disposed of **43.78** tons of C&D debris during March 2011 and the Candia recycling Center disposed of **59.88** tons of C&D debris during March 2010. The Candia Recycling Center disposed of **30.10** tons of C&D debris during March 2009.

The Total amount of waste processed for the month of March 2014 was **68.85** tons. The total amount of waste processed for the month of March 2013 was **83.82** tons. The total amount of waste processed for the month of March 2012 was **94.32** tons. The total amount of waste processed in March 2011 was **100.26** tons. The total amount of waste processed during March 2010 was **122.28** tons and the total amount of waste processed during March 2009 was **81.31** tons.

The baler was repaired and put back into service in Mid March.

Moore Park

The park is coming to life again, with the snowy winter this year finally giving way to Spring and activities starting up. The Easter Egg Hunt went off Saturday, April 12th, a week later than last year. A great success, I'm sure, thanks to the efforts of Linda McCabe and the other dedicated volunteers. There is a Field Day scheduled for next Saturday, April 19th, rain or shine. Many different town groups, including Jesse Remington High School and the Moore School softball team have and are helping out. Help from the public is welcomed and has been solicited. The Moore School softball season has started with a full schedule. CYAA will, again this year, be using the front ball field at Moore Park on a regular basis. The Road Agent will be giving the basketball court its annual professional sweeping and doing road maintenance. The bathrooms are up and running after minor repairs and maintenance were completed. Don Drouin, a local plumber, did a professional job of reinstalling the toilets to the floor, donating some of his time in the process. Paul Rogers, a part-time recycling center employee will be working part-time with me in the park this year. He will be opening and closing the bathrooms as many days each week as possible within the existing budget. The effort to support the unfunded portion of the requested budget for that line will have to come, as I suggested at budget time, from volunteer labor. I'll be looking for volunteers. Volunteer equipment repair in the playground is in-process. The playground surface will need to be redone this year, using money from both the trust fund and the increased funding in the operating budget maintenance line

Skateboard Park

The park appears to have survived the winter, is functional and is being used on a daily basis. Sealcoating the asphalt surface is being reviewed.

Ski Program & Summer Recreation

The ski programs are now fully run by the CYAA. They did a super job of managing the program at no cost to the town. No formal town summer recreation programs are scheduled, but we'll be working with the CYAA and other groups, entities and organizations, as we have in past years, to provide support for their programs.

Pond Park and Gazebo Area

I'm working with the road agent and the school district to stabilize the area and be able to regularly mow the area immediately adjacent to the North side of the parking lot. The Gazebo is going to need some work this year.

Conservation Commission

The commission has hired Donna DelRosso as their administrative assistant, replacing Mimi Alberu. They approved an hourly pay rate of \$12.57/hour.

Economic Development

The effort by SNHPC with the support from our Conservation and Heritage Commissions to participate in the Proposed Upper Lamprey Scenic Byway project has now reached the implementation phase. I'm working with SNHPC to complete the Candia portion of the corridor management plan in a manner that will fully utilize the potential of the corridor to enhance Candia's economic benefits for our existing business community.
