





This letter serves as notice that I am resigning from my appointment to the Recycling/Energy Committee.

The key reason for this is a result of the very poor actions by the Board of Selectmen at last night's meeting regarding the appointment of Rudy Cartier to the committee.

Although I have limited knowledge of the past circumstances regarding Mr. Cartier's actions as Fire Chief, what I do know is that Mr. Cartier questioned the accusations against him, and was re-instated as Fire Chief by the Board. It would seem that this action clears Mr. Cartier of any wrong doing and should have cleared up any past issues.

What is most pathetic about the Board's actions is that they DID NOT bother to ask Mr. Cartier any questions, nor did they offer to meet with Mr. Cartier in a non-public session so he could address any questions.

What would the Board have had to lose by meeting with Mr. Cartier? If nothing else, they would have at least had the appearance of being somewhat cooperative by offering to meet, even if they did not intend to put aside their past prejudice towards Mr. Cartier.

Last night's meeting was certainly very discouraging for any potential volunteers in town. This Board seems to be following the ways of past Boards by trying to discourage volunteers in town. I personally have been the victim of this sort of treatment in the past. (Not to mention there has not been a word of thanks for many, many hours of work over the years.)

Attitude is everything, and the Board's attitude should be to *encourage* volunteers and committees. If this Board feels that volunteers and committees are a bother and will interfere with what they are doing, then the Board needs to change their attitude. The idea should be to *welcome* feedback, ideas, and yes: criticism. With the right attitude, the Board can review the input and move forward in the best ways possible.
