Work Summary:


There were 2 salt/sand runs and no plowable storms.

The MSW (Municipal Solid Waste) totals were unavailable for this report.

Recyclables

Mix Paper – 13 bales = 19,743 lbs. = 9.87 ton

Cardboard – 9 bales 12,789 lbs. = 6.39 ton

#1 -#7 plastics – 5 bales = 5880 lbs. = 2.94 ton

Aluminum Cans – 2 bales 1604 lbs. = .80 ton

#2 natural plastics – 1 bale = 860 lbs. = .43 ton

The 30 bales created during November 2017 weighed 40,876 lbs. or 20.44 tons. On 11/3 the electronic contained was hauled, there was 6120 lbs. or 3.06 tons of electronics recycled and on 11/28 there was one load of glass recycled that weighed approximately 21,500 lbs. or 10.75 tons. There was a grand total of 68,496 lbs. or 34.25 tons recycled during November 2017.

On 11/3 there was a load of paper/cardboard that was sent out, 13.14 tons of mix paper and 8.93 tons of cardboard generated \$736.45.

On 11/17 two loads of scrap metal were sent out, 18.32 tons of light iron generated \$1799.29 in revenue.

There was \$2535.74 in revenue generated during November 2017 and as of 12/8 the CRC (Candia Recycling Center) has generated \$58,941.69 in revenue during 2017.
