Programming

Discussion / brainstorming ensued on potential Education/Outreach projects, which included new historic markers, a walking tour map and guide, e-newsletter, HC pamphlet, and a possible historic bus tour in conjunction with Old Home Day 2008, and the desire to incorporate this information on the town website. Chris will check with the webmaster about the website and locate information relating to a 1990s era OHD bus tour.
