Are you in favor of the adoption of Article 2 as follows:

Shall the District approve the cost items included in the collective bargaining agreement reached between the Candia School Board and the Candia Education Association, which calls for the following increase in salaries and benefits at the current staffing levels:

*In addition there is an early retirement incentive increase, for this year only, the cost of which is capped at \$50,000. If the incentive is taken, it is likely that departing staff will be replaced by new staff significantly lower on the salary schedule, thereby resulting in a net savings to the district.

ARTICLE 3

Are you in favor of the adoption of Article 3 as follows:

Shall the District vote to raise and appropriate as an operating budget, not including appropriations by special warrant articles and other appropriations voted separately, the amounts set forth on the budget posted with the Warrant, or as amended by vote of the first session, for the purpose set forth therein, totaling seven million, eight hundred ninety thousand, seven hundred forty-one dollars (\$7,890,741)? Should this article be defeated, the default budget shall be seven million, nine hundred thirty-three thousand, one hundred forty dollars (\$7,933,140), which is the same as last year, with certain adjustments required by previous action of the Candia School District, or by law; or the governing body may hold one special meeting, in accordance with RSA 40:13, X and XVI, to take up the issue of a revised operating budget only. (This article does not include appropriations in any other warrant articles.) (Recommended by the School Board) (Recommended by the Budget Committee)

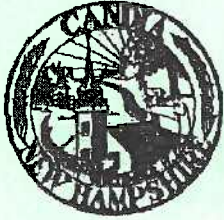

Should this article be defeated, the default budget shall be Two Million Three Hundred Sixty-Four Thousand Four Hundred and Fifty-Three Dollars (\$2,364,453), which is the same as last year, with certain adjustments required by previous action of the Town of Candia or by law; or the governing body may hold one special meeting, in accordance with RSA 40:13, X and XVI, to take up the issue of a revised operating budget only. (Recommended by the Board of Selectmen by a vote of 5 to 0) (Recommended by the Budget Committee by a vote of 8 to 0)
