September 5, 2024 Thursday 7:00 PM Candia Town Hall

Call to Order

- *Chair Matt Cobb called the meeting to order at 7:07PM.
- *Pledge of Allegiance was recited by Commission Members and Alternates.

Regular Business

*Approval of Minutes from Last Meeting on August 1, 2024.

-Moved by Darrel Nafranowicz, seconded by Tom DiMaggio, passed unanimously.

*Treasurer's Report

-The account balance is \$5,684.71. Deposits, expenses, and interest were reviewed. A trailer for the Farmer's Market was purchased and registered. Approval of the treasurer's report was moved by Melissa Madden and seconded by Darrel Nafranowicz, passed unanimously.

Old Business

*Farmer's Market

- -A foldable picnic table and trailer were purchased. The trailer was used last month for the Farmer's Market and it was very helpful for transporting needed items.
- -The August Farmer's Market was successful. Less fish was ordered and most of it was sold. There were a few new vendors this month.
- -There is an Open House on 11/29-Black Friday at Charmingfare Farm. There will be hay and train rides, campfires. There will be approximately 20-25 vendors invited. The Farmer's Market will advertise this event and will receive the vendor fees. A notice will be sent out to the vendors/artisans. The state said if the town approves, there can be alcohol sold there. There will be food options.
- -There was a conversation with a representative of the state Vouchers for Veterans Program. Melissa Madden could train for this at the winter markets. If Vouchers for Veterans participates at the Candia Farmer's Market 3 volunteers would be needed and they would cover the cost and supplies.
- -Volunteers are needed for September. There will be fresh apple cider and an apple pie baking contest with 17 applicants so far.
 - -Posters were distributed to the Agricultural Commission members.
 - -There is no more room to add more vendors in October.
- -It was suggested that the children's table volunteers be remembered if leftover items are given out.
- -There was a discussion around the importance of keeping the Agricultural Commission linked with the Farmer's Market.
- -It was suggested that there be a raffle for the vendors and there be a monthly theme. There could be an independent judge for the best vendor displayed theme. A judge and volunteers would be needed for this. There could be an acknowledgement/recognition of a volunteer at each Farmer's Market.
 - -A volunteer coordinator is needed for the Farmer's Markets.

*Barn Program

-Paperwork for renewals has been submitted to the Selectman for review next week.

*Lecture Series

- -On 9/26 Fish and Game will be presenting on Bobcats at the Library. This event will be posted on the Agricultural Commission Facebook page.
- -Pattie Davis/Melissa Madden will reach out to a person who does pasta making and see if they can do a presentation in November.
- -Matt Cobb talked with Lamprey River Series to see if they will be able to present in January or February.
- -Matt Cobb talked to Nick Karacoudas to see if he can do a presentation related to crops.
- -Other possible topics include composting, canning, crocheting/knitting, quilting, homesteading.

New Business

*Budget for Next Year

-It was decided there will not be a warrant article submitted requesting money.

*Agriculture Day at the School

-Meg Morenz will be in charge for this event that will be held in the spring of 2025.

*Donations for the Food Pantry

-It was suggested that attendees at the Farmer's Markets could purchase items from the vendors and donate them to the Candia food pantry.

-There was a discussion around the Agricultural Commission possibly donating money to the food pantry and requesting that a representative from the Women's Club attend a meeting to talk about their program.

-There is a NH Grows program that could be promoted to facilitate donations of fresh produce to the food pantry.

*Senior Lunch Program

-There was a discussion around the Agricultural Commission contributing money to the senior lunch program and providing a holiday meal.
