There were 14 spreader runs & 6 storms to plow


Patching was done as needed



January 2017

The Candia Recycling Center land-filled **67.09** tons of Municipal Solid Waste (MSW) during January 2017. The Recycling Center sent out **19.40** tons of C&D debris to a Construction and Demolition recycling facility. There was **86.49** tons of waste processed through the Candia recycling Center during January 2017.

Recyclables

Mix Paper – 11 bales = 16,958 lbs. = 8.48 tons

Cardboard - 9 bales = 11,900 lbs. = 5.95 tons

#1-#7 plastics - 3 bales = 3586 lbs. = 1.79 tons

Aluminum cans – 3 bales = 2301 lbs. = 1.15 tons

Total bales – 26 = 34,745 lbs. = 17.37 tons

There was one load of glass sent out which weighed **11.53** tons.

On 1/18 there were **13.77** tons of Mix Paper and **8.92** tons of Cardboard marketed which generated **\$1353.60** in revenue.

On 1/16 there was **5505** lbs. of Aluminum cans marketed which generated **\$2,972.70** in revenue.

There was also **4367** lbs. of various non-ferrous metals marketed which generated **\$2044.31** in revenue.

Total revenue for January 2017 is **\$6370.61**.

February 2017

The Candia Recycling Center land-filled **51.08** tons of Municipal Solid Waste (MSW). The CRC sent out **17.16** tons of C&D debris to a C&D Recycling facility. The total amount of waste processed at the Candia Recycling Center during February 2017 is **68.24** tons.

Recyclables

Mix Paper – 9 bales = **13,822** lbs. = **6.91** tons

Cardboard – 6 bales = **8,340** lbs. = **4.17** tons

Tin Cans – 4 bales = **5,345** lbs. = **2.67** tons

#1-#7 mixed plastics – 3 bales = **3,460** lbs. = **1.73** tons

Aluminum cans – 1 bale = **1,085** lbs. = **.54** tons

#2 Natural Plastics – 1 bale = **719** lbs. = **.36** tons

There were **24** bales of recyclables created during Feb. 2017 that weighed **16.38** tons and there was also one glass load sent out that weighed **11.15** tons. This gives a total amount of **27.53** tons recycled.

We sent out one load of #1-#7 plastics that weighed approx. **27,000** lbs. and will generate approx. **\$540** in revenue.
