

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

Dear Board of Selectmen:

This letter is to request one thousand, two-hundred fifty dollars (**\$1,250**) in funds from the Town of Candia from the **2020 budget**. The Child Advocacy Center of Rockingham County (CACRC) is a 501c (3) non-profit agency. The town of Candia has historically supported the CACRC to offset expenses so the center can concentrate on doing what we do best, offer support and advocacy for child abuse victims and their families.

A cost benefit analysis from **National Children's Alliance** found communities with a Child Advocacy Center save on average \$1,500 per child abuse investigation. Since opening our doors in 2000, the Derry and Portsmouth centers have served over **6,800** children. This equates to **10 million dollars** in savings to the residents of Rockingham County.

It's our nature to take care of children, and helping protect them from abuse has become a critical service of our time. I am respectfully requesting the Town of Candia continue to support the CACRC in their 2020 town budget.

Statistical Data for Town of Candia 2020 Budget Request

The Child Advocacy Center of Rockingham County, an accredited program, provides a safe environment for the evaluation of alleged physical and sexual abuse for children 3 to 18 years of age. We coordinate public, private and community partners to ensure that the safety, health and well-being of abused children come first. Since opening our doors in January of 2000, we have provided professional services to over **6,800** children and their families at no cost to them or taxpayers. How much a society values its children can be measured by how well they are treated and protected.

Our Vision

- We believe our multidisciplinary approach is the best way to serve the needs of children and their families impacted by child abuse.
- We will always respond to requests for our services.
- We will coordinate multidisciplinary teams for the child's benefit.
- We will coordinate ongoing support services to the children and their families.
- We will educate our community and partners to prevent child abuse.

Cost Benefit Analysis from the National Children's Alliance

- Traditional investigations were **38% more expensive** than using a Child Advocacy Center (CAC).
- The average cost of a traditional investigation was \$4,000 compared to \$2,500 for an investigation involving a CAC. A **\$1,500 savings** per case.
- Brought in private dollars for child maltreatment services that would not otherwise be available through other child serving agencies.

Community Benefits of a CAC Investigation

- Child victims and their family have greater access to medical exams and mental health services.
- More involvement by law enforcement in child abuse investigations.
- Greater satisfaction by the non-offending caregiver with the investigation process.
- Forensic Interviews, as part of the CAC model, are evidence-based.

Town of Candia Statistics

- Number of Candia children interviewed at the CACRC to date in 2019 = **4**
- Number of Candia children interviewed in 2018 = **7**
- Billing for Candia residents to insurance, Medicare, or individuals – **NONE**
- Dollars received from Rockingham County and the State of NH = **4%** of our operating budget
- Savings to the town of Candia in 2017 and to date 2018 - **\$16,500**
- According to NCA cost benefit analysis, savings to Rockingham County since opening our doors is over **\$10 million** to date.
