At the most recent meeting of the Agriculture Commission the commission voted to make several recommendations to the select board regarding our upcoming terms.

First, William Haas has tendered his resignation as a voting member due to increased work and family demands. Mr Haas' term expired 2021. The commission has voted unanimously to recommend the appointment of Ron Howe, currently an alternate to this position in a new three-year term which would end 2024. Mr Howe is a longterm resident of Candia and active in the agricultural community. Since his appointment as an alternate he has been a valuable asset to the commission.

Second, Debra Cobb and Joseph Lamarche both have alternate terms expiring this March. Both have been consistent and valuable contributors to the commission, and both would like to continue in their roles.
