For one thing, this would have a detrimental effect on the others in the office who would see it as her being above them. In addition, the term "administrator" is a hot button item in discussions around town and we should not subject Lisa to that discussion.

I am more in favor of re-evaluating her pay scale and providing tangible benefits for her level work and dedication. Or, if a new title is, for some reason, needed, something more in the line of Land Use Coordinator might be more appropriate.

Because of Kevin's relatively brief tenure as Lisa's supervisor, I was obligated to write her annual performance evaluation. It concluded with the following:

While that is correct, it is an inaccurate and incomplete description of her duties as they have evolved and been embraced by her. Dear Select Board,

At the most recent meeting of the Agriculture Commission the commission voted to make several recommendations to the select board regarding our upcoming terms.

First, William Haas has tendered his resignation as a voting member due to increased work and family demands. Mr Haas' term expired 2021. The commission has voted unanimously to recommend the appointment of Ron Howe, currently an alternate to this position in a new three-year term which would end 2024. Mr Howe is a longterm resident of Candia and active in the agricultural community. Since his appointment as an alternate he has been a valuable asset to the commission.

Second, Debra Cobb and Joseph Lamarche both have alternate terms expiring this March. Both have been consistent and valuable contributors to the commission, and both would like to continue in their roles. The commission has voted unanimously to recommend that they both be reappointed for further 3-year terms as alternates ending 2024.

I would be happy to attend your meeting when these recommendations are considered and answer any questions the Select Board might have.
