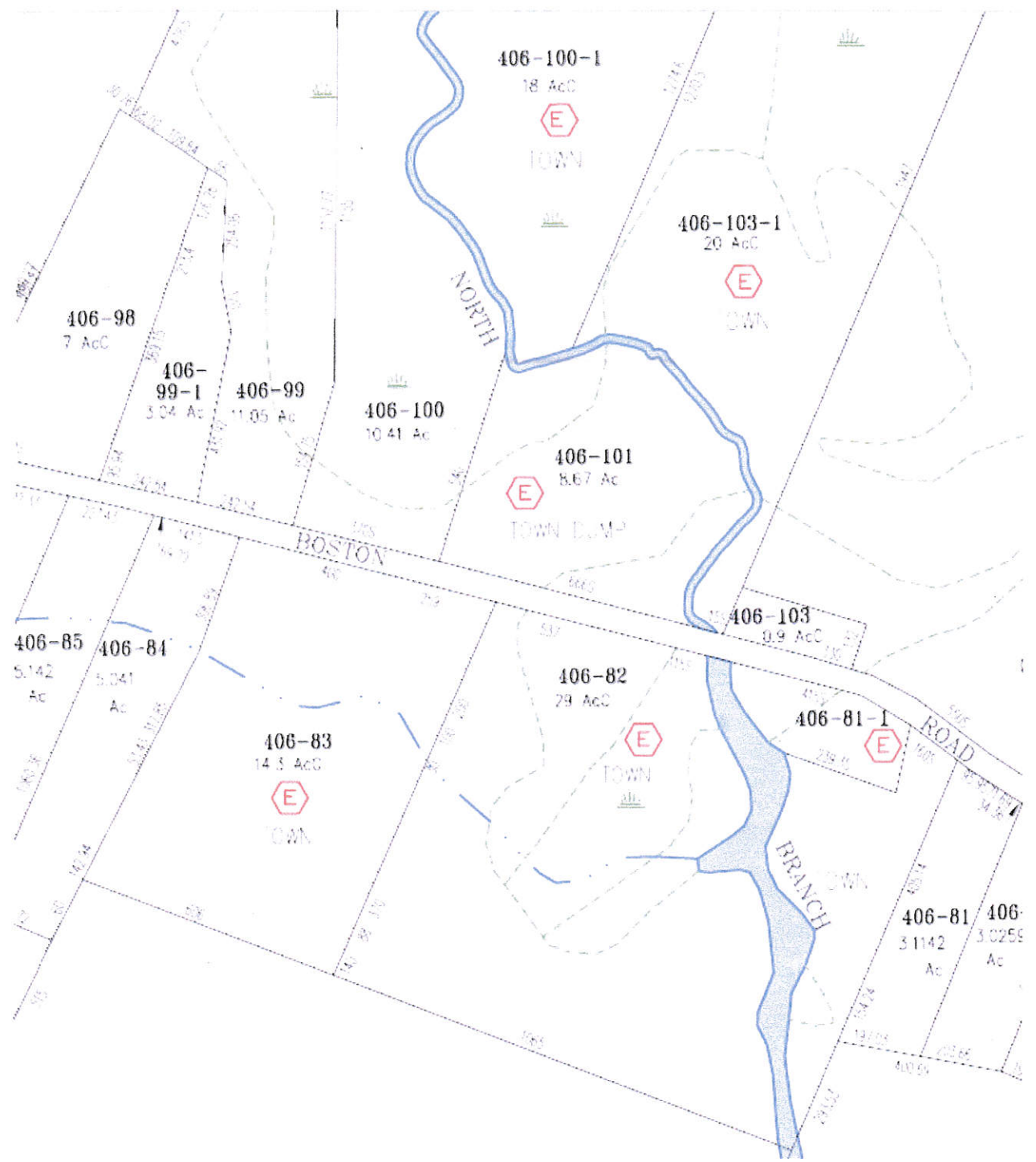

CHAPTER 674 LOCAL LAND USE PLANNING AND REGULATORY POWERS

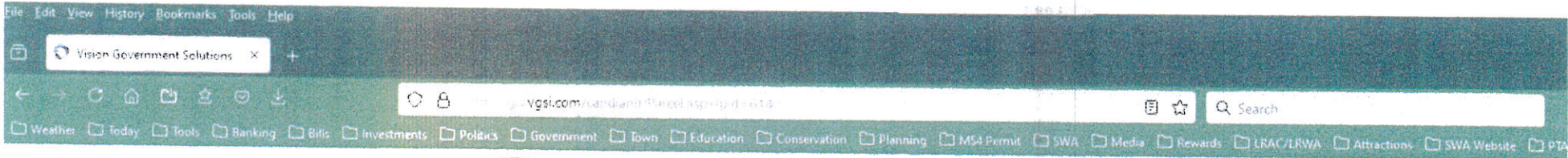
Regulation of Subdivision of Land

Section 674:39-a

674:39-a Voluntary Merger. –

- I. Any owner of 2 or more contiguous preexisting approved or subdivided lots or parcels who wishes to merge them for municipal regulation and taxation purposes may do so by applying to the planning board or its designee. Except as set forth in paragraphs II and III, all such requests shall be approved, and no public hearing or notice shall be required. No new survey plat need be recorded, but a notice of the merger, sufficient to identify the relevant parcels and endorsed in writing by the planning board or its designee, shall be filed for recording in the registry of deeds, and a copy mailed to the municipality's assessing officials. No such merged parcel shall thereafter be separately transferred without subdivision approval. No city, town, county, or village district may merge preexisting subdivided lots or parcels except upon the consent of the owner.
- II. If there is any mortgage on any of the lots, the applicant shall give written notice to each mortgage holder at the time of the submission of the application. The written consent of each mortgage holder shall be required as a condition of approval of the merger, and shall be recorded with the notice of the merger pursuant to paragraph I. Upon recordation of the notice and each consent, the mortgage or mortgages shall be deemed by operation of law to apply to all lots involved in the merger. The municipality shall not be liable for any deficiency in the notice to mortgage holders.
- III. No merger shall be approved that would create a violation of then-current ordinances or regulations.

SUBJECT: Automated External Defibrillators for Henry Moore School

Background:

Earlier this year, the Town approved the funding to purchase AEDs for the fire department which would allow each fire apparatus, police vehicle, the library, the town office, and the transfer station to have the same model AED. The fire department now maintains ownership of the AEDs for ease of servicing the devices and obtaining replacement pads and batteries.

We discussed purchasing AEDs for the Henry Moore School but at the time the fire department had not had an opportunity to discuss with the school's administration. Since that time, we have been able to evaluate the school's current AEDs and again have found them to be outdated and beyond their serviceable life. The current AEDs at the school are dated with the 2005 guidelines, which puts the AEDs well outside their service life and does not have the most updated, evidence-based guidelines for defibrillation.

Discussion

As discussed earlier this year, having updated equipment and consistency throughout the town is imperative to quick treatments for those suffering a cardiac emergency. Having the fire department purchase and maintain ownership of these devices allows our experienced personnel to perform necessary preventative maintenance, order the appropriate supplies, and replace them as needed through our internal capital improvement plans.

Some of the benefits of these AEDs compared to the ones we have:

- Batteries are good for 4 years.
- Pads are good for 4 years and have a replacement cost of \$127.
- Pads offer treatment for both adults and children (current AEDs do not cover children).
- Pads can be plugged into our LIFEPAK 15 monitors.
- No preventative maintenance costs.
- 8-year warranty and a minimum of 10-year shelf life.
- Training provided by Stryker to town employees.

These devices are utilized in conjunction with our ambulance service and the care that our personnel provide. This is an opportunity for the department to utilize funding from our ambulance revenue account to purchase these items so that they do not need to be purchased through the town's operating budget.

Recommendation:

The fire department purchases three (3) LIFEPAK CR2 AEDs for \$5,679, minus trade-in value for the three outdated AEDs (approximately \$300-600) out of the ambulance revenue account.
