So please, let's all do our part to keep our roadways safe!



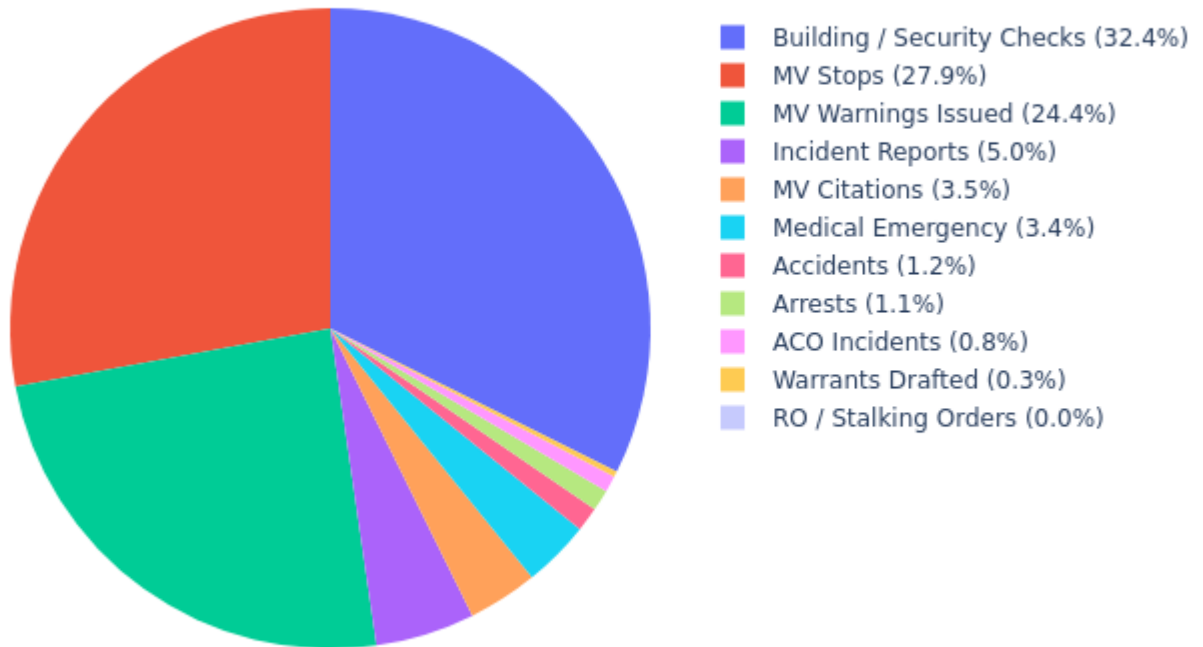
